



2010 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

ELIGIBILITY: Schalmont DFS will be giving scholarship awards to graduating seniors of the class of 2010 who are entering their first year of post-secondary education in academic year 2010/2011.

GENERAL CRITERIA: (1) Employment and/or community/school activities, (2) Academic achievement, (3) Statement of your future goals. Special circumstances, as described by you, may also be taken into consideration. **All personal identifying information will be withheld and the selections will be made anonymously.**

Our goal every year is to award at least six (6) \$500 scholarships divided among four-year, two year and technical/vocation programs.

For 2010 graduates, we are also offering the following scholarships. Please note that additional criteria may apply.

SPECIAL NAMED SCHOLARSHIPS

All applicants for named scholarships must fill out a Dollars for Scholars application. Some scholarships have additional criteria that must be met, also.

Michael Sarandrea Memorial Scholarship: This scholarship, in the amount of \$1,000 is given in memory of a former Schalmont High School student. General criteria do **not** apply. To be eligible for this scholarship students must fill out a Dollars for Scholars application and pick up instructions from the Guidance Office.

Christopher Nicholas Memorial Award: Named in honor of Christopher Nicholas, a member of the Schalmont Class of 1988, who was active in Scouting for much of his life, the \$250 scholarship will be awarded each year for the next three years to someone who will pursue computer studies and who, preferably, participated in Boy or Girl Scouts.

Timothy Slider Memorial Scholarship: This scholarship, in the amount of \$500, will be awarded in memory of a former Schalmont Middle School student, who passed away several years ago, and who would have graduated this year. Applicants must meet the general criteria.

Jeffrey Brockenborough Memorial Scholarship: This scholarship, in an amount to be announced, is awarded by the Class of 1989 in memory of Jeffrey Brockenborough, a member of the class of '89 and a football player. To be eligible for this scholarship students must fill out a Dollars for Scholars application and meet additional criteria as stated on the attached page.

Jeffrey Brockenborough Memorial Scholarship

Jeffrey Brockenborough was a member of the Schalmont Class of '89. During his time at Schalmont, Jeff was a member of the Schalmont Varsity Football team. His 6'5" frame, great hands and bruising strength made him one of the most dominant wide receivers in Section II. After the reinstatement of football at Schalmont in 1985, Jeff became the first player at Schalmont to be named 1st Team All-State and helped lead the Sabres to a winning season during his senior year. In addition to football, Jeff was a good student and was one of the most likeable members of his class. After graduation, Jeff went on to play football at Union College and then continued his education at SUNY Albany. Jeff began his career in the financial sector of New York City and was ultimately named the director of the Depository Trust Clearing Corporation. Jeff was quiet but not shy and his overall character was what everyone should strive to achieve.

Jeff passed away on January 14, 2006. Although his life was cut short at just 34 years of age, his positive impact on his family and friends during that time was meaningful and important and we are all better people for knowing him.

In memory of Jeff and in celebration of the Class of '89 20-year reunion this past year, we have created this scholarship. The award will go to a member of the Schalmont Varsity Football team from the fall 2009 season that is graduating in June 2010. The recipient needs to be attending a two-year or four-year college beginning in the fall of 2010. Please submit a short essay (2 pages max.) describing your qualifications (academic and extra-curricular) and why you feel you are most deserving of this scholarship. All qualified seniors are encouraged to apply.
