

Schalmont Teachers' Association Scholarships

Each year the Schalmont Teachers' Association offers three \$1,000 scholarships to eligible graduating seniors. The scholarships and the criteria for each are as follows:

1. Schalmont Teachers' Association Senior Scholarship I (\$1,000)

Criteria for 1:

- ❖ Applicants must be continuing their education at a two or four year college or university
- ❖ Applicants should be serious students. (The scholarship committee will request your transcript to be attached to this application).
- ❖ Applicants should be good citizens.
- ❖ Other financial awards or "need" will not be a consideration.

2. Schalmont Teachers' Association Senior Scholarship II (\$1,000) (Presented to a senior planning a career in education)

Criteria for 2:

- ❖ Applications must be continuing their education at a two or four year college or university where they plan to pursue a career in education.
- ❖ Applicants should be serious students. (The scholarship committee will request your transcript to be attached to this application).
- ❖ Applicants should be good citizens.
- ❖ Other financial awards or "need" will not be a consideration.

3. Schalmont Teachers' Association Memorial Scholarship (\$1,000) to honor Schalmont teachers who have died while in service.

Criteria for Memorial Scholarship:

- ❖ Applicants must be continuing their education at a two or four year college or university.
- ❖ Applicants should be serious students.
- ❖ Applicants should be good school citizens.
- ❖ Applicants should be involved in an activity/organization that has made a personal, positive impact and has also impacted the lives of others in the Capital District Region.
- ❖ Other financial awards or "need" will not be a consideration.
