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REQUIREMENTS TO GET ELA CLASS CREDIT:

- Read ONE book cover to cover (age-appropriate)
- Total 8 (eight) hours reading or alternate activities (see below) throughout the summer, plus read ONE book cover to cover
- Alternate activities include the following:
 - **READING:**
 - Books
 - Magazines
 - Newspapers
 - Internet articles
 - Instruction manuals or directions
 - Recipes
 - Travel guides/brochures
 - Reading aloud, to anyone, including younger children
 - **LISTENING:**
 - Audio books (playaways, mp3 downloads, CDs, etc)
 - **WRITING:**
 - Creative or technical writing
 - Writing in a journal
 - Writing poetry, plays, etc

**These alternate activities will be counted in minutes, not by the activities themselves, totaling 8 hours, or 480 minutes for the summer.*

REWARDS FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE SR CLUB:

- Read one book cover to cover (age appropriate).**

For every 20 minutes engaged in reading or alternate activities, you'll get your name put into the drawing for the BIG prize (one BIG prize per grade so better chances of winning).

- Read one book cover to cover (age appropriate), plus spend at least 240 minutes reading or engaged in any of the alternate activities.**

For every 20 minutes engaged in reading or alternate activities, you'll get your name put into the drawing for the BIG prize AND an invitation to a SR Club party in September.

- Read one book cover to cover (age appropriate), plus spend at least 480 minutes reading or engaged in any of the alternate activities.**

For every 20 minutes engaged in reading or alternate activities, you'll get your name put into the drawing for the BIG prize, an invitation to a SR Club party in September, AND get an A+ averaged into your first semester ELA grade.

How would you like to share with the librarian how you participated in the Summer Reading Club?

This sheet must be handed in to Mrs Fasano upon return to school, no later than September 9, 2011.
