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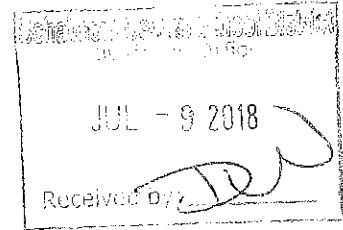

3. NON-COLLUSIVE BIDDING CERTIFICATION: THIS CERTIFICATION MUST BE COMPLETED SIGNED AND SUBMITTED WITH THE BID.
4. THE BOARD OF EDUCATION RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REJECT ANY BID IF EVIDENCE SUBMITTED BY BIDDER OR THE BOARD'S INVESTIGATION OF THE BIDDER FAILS TO SATISFY THE BOARD THAT SUCH BIDDER IS PROPERLY QUALIFIED TO CARRY OUT THE OBLIGATION OF THE CONTRACT, OR THAT THE INFORMATION PROVIDED ON THE SPECIFICATION DOES NOT MEET THE SPECIFICATIONS OF THE BOARD.
