

By-Laws

SUBJECT: CANDIDACY FOR OFFICE OF MEMBER OF BOARD OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES (BOCES)

Any resident of the Schalmont District who desires to be a candidate for the office of Board member of the Board of Cooperative Education shall present a petition signed by twenty-five qualified voters directed to the District Clerk. The petition shall state the name and residence of the candidate and shall clearly state that the candidate is presenting his/her name to the Schalmont Board of Education for consideration to be nominated to the BOCES Board of Education. A short biographical resume may be attached to the petition but this is not a requirement. No employee of the School District is eligible for election to the BOCES Board.

Petitions of candidacy will be made available at the District office no later than seven (7) days after receipt of notice of election from the BOCES Superintendent.

Each petition shall be filed with the Schalmont Clerk not later than the fourteenth day preceding the closing date for nomination as set by the BOCES Clerk.

The Schalmont Board by majority vote may select one (1) or more candidates whose nomination will be made to the Clerk of the Cooperative Board at least fourteen (14) days prior to their annual meeting.
