

## By-Laws

**SUBJECT: LEGAL QUALIFICATIONS OF VOTERS AT SCHOOL DISTRICT MEETINGS**

The chairperson of the Annual District Meeting and Election/Budget Vote will preside over the election/vote process.

A person shall be entitled to vote on any District meeting or election, who:

- a) Is a citizen of the United States
- b) Is eighteen (18) years of age or older
- c) Is not disqualified from registering or voting at an election in accordance with Section 5 – 106 of the Election Law
- d) Has been a resident of the District for a period of thirty (30) days next preceding the meeting at which he/she offers to vote, and presents proof of such residency. Such proof shall be required to be presented prior to signing the poll list kept by the District, and shall consist of either a valid driver's license, a non-driver identification card, a utility bill, or a voter registration card.
