SUBJECT: OPERATION OF MOTOR-DRIVEN VEHICLES ON DISTRICT PROPERTY

The use of motor-driven vehicles, including cars, snowmobiles, mini-bikes, motorcycles, all-terrain vehicles (ATV's) and other such vehicles is prohibited on any school grounds or areas except for authorized school functions or purposes.

Student Driving and Parking

The Board of Education provides transportation for students and it should be considered the primary means of transportation to and from school. The Board of Education will grant students permission to drive to and from school provided they have a demonstrated need that would include: family reasons, employment, or other educational programs. The student must also have a valid New York State driver's license. The Board of Education will provide a designated student parking area at the High School. Students and their parents or guardian will sign a written parking/student agreement.
