**SUBJECT: WEAPONS IN SCHOOL**

All dangerous weapons are prohibited in school buildings or on School District Property. Any object which is unnecessary for school activities and which could be used as a weapon is not to be brought to school unless written permission is granted by the building principal. If such items are brought to school, without principal approval, they will be confiscated by the teacher and/or principal and are returnable only to the parent by the principal. All guns confiscated will be turned over to the local Police Department.

Any student found in possession of any dangerous weapon or objects may be suspended for a period of five (5) school days and his/her parents will be notified.

NOTE: Refer also to Policies #3411 -- Unlawful Possession of a Weapon Upon School Grounds and #7361 - Gun-Free Schools.
