SUBJECT: ALTERNATIVE INSTRUCTION

Alternative Instruction is that instruction required to be provided to a student who is of compulsory attendance age and who has been suspended from school as a result of a Superintendent's hearing.

Procedures for students requiring homebound instruction shall be developed under the direction of the Superintendent of Schools. The Director of Pupil Personnel Services will be responsible for implementing procedures and reviewing the policy on a regular basis.

Alternative instruction will be in the core academic subjects. Students will receive academic credit for work completed while on homebound instruction, as graded by the homebound instructor or the student's teacher.

Instruction shall be provided: One (1) hour daily for elementary students K-6 (**total of 5 hours**)
Two (2) hours daily for secondary students 7-12 (**total of 10 hours**)
