2019 Fall Recreation Soccer Program

Registration The Rotterdam United Soccer Club fall rec registrations will be online at www.ruscny.org. All registrations must be done online - Go to the Rec Program tab – Fall Registration. The cost of registration is \$100 per player, \$200 for two, etc. If you sign up during the “**EARLY BIRD REGISTRATION**” period the fees are the following:

\$ 75 for one player
\$135 for two players and
\$185 for a family with three or more players.

The “EARLY BIRD REGISTRATON” period is from June 1, 2019 until July 15, 2019 ONLY.

Online orders are date and time stamped so no excuses will be allowed if you miss “EBR” deadline. No back-dated checks will not be accepted either. The children will be provided with a soccer shirt, shorts, and socks. **A LATE FEE of \$25.00 for any registration not paid within 25 days of origin or by September 7, 2019, whichever is shorter. A payment reminder email will be sent between 7-10 days after registration is received.**

The Recreation Program will run on Saturdays for eight consecutive weeks, beginning on **September 7, 2019** and ending on **October 26, 2019**. Game times are as follows:

Session 1: 9:00 - 10:30 3rd & 4th Grade Girls (practice Monday nights)
Session 2: 11:00 - 12:30 1st & 2nd Grade Girls and 3rd & 4th Grade Boys (practice Tuesday nights)
Session 3: 1:00 - 2:30 Kindergarten and 1st & 2nd Grade Boys (practice Wednesday nights)
Session 4: 3:00 - 4:45 5th & 6th Grade Girls and 5th & 6th Grade Boys (practice Thursday nights)

Coaches will call their players directly. You should expect to receive a call from your child’s coach during the week of **August 25, 2019**. Please be patient because some coaches may be on vacation. If you haven’t received a call by September 1, 2019, send an email to fallrec@rusc.org.

Picture Day will take place on **September 21, 2019**. Coaches will distribute information packets and the schedule to their team.

Uniform Pick-up/ Clinic will be held Saturday, **August 24, 2019**. All coaches and assistant coaches are **required** to come this day to get your team uniforms and rosters between 9:00 - 10:00 am. A coaches’ clinic (depending on numbers) may run from 10:00-11:00 am.

Field Take Down will take place after the last games on Saturday, **October 26, 2019**. Please make an effort to stay and assist us.

REFUND POLICY

Refunds will be made by your method of payment received (either check or credit card reversal) by the Club Treasurer. All requests for a refund must be made in writing or by email. No changes to this policy or refund amounts will be allowed. **Please understand your refund is solely based on the time of your request.**

- A full refund will be made when requested prior to **August 1, 2019**.
- On/after **August 1, 2019**, a \$25 deduction will be made to cover uniform costs from the refund amount.
- After **September 7, 2019**, the first weekend of the season, a 50% refund will be provided.
- There will be no refunds given after **September 14 2019**.

Where multiple family discounts apply, the refund will not exceed the registration fee for the family member paying the least.

FAMILY VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS

The Rotterdam United Soccer Club continues to invest in upgrades to our soccer fields. This continued investment is possible in part because of proceeds from the concession stand. Each team will be asked to provide volunteers to staff the concession stand (1 of the 8 weeks for approximately 2 hours). It is vital to our success that volunteers from each team are ready to assist on the day their team is assigned to help.

Your participation is not only appreciated but is greatly needed.

Spectators will be required to sit on the side of the field opposite the teams. This will allow coaches to use the sidelines to provide direction and instruction to players without putting spectators, players, or them at risk of injury. Spectators should be at **least two (2') feet off the sidelines.**
