BUDGET DEVELOPMENT TIMELINE

ATTENTION Schalmont community, The budget season for 2020-21, much like many things in our world, has been affected by the school closures around the state. In an effort to keep New Yorkers safe during the COVID-19 pandemic, Governor Andrew M. Cuomo issued an executive order delaying school board elections and budget votes statewide until **June 9, 2020**. The school board elections and budget votes **will all be conducted by mail** and all qualified voters will be sent an absentee ballot with return postage paid.
