

"Recommended Motion" NOTICE OF THE BUDGET HEARING AND ANNUAL Moved by: DISTRICT MEETING/ELECTION TO THE OUALIFIED VOTES OF THE Seconded by: Schalmont Central School District at Rotterdam, Schenectady County, New York. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that a public hearing of the qualified votes of the Schalmont Central School District at Rotterdam, will be held in the Middle School Building in said District on Monday, May 4, 2021 at 7:00 PM prevailing time. The budget presentation will be held virtually with the access information listed on the District website 24 hours prior to the meeting. The budget will be available for review starting April 27, 2021 via the District website. NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN, that the annual school election of the qualified voters of the Schalmont Central School district of Rotterdam, will be held at the High School in said District on May 18, 2021 between the hours of 6:00 AM and 9:00 PM prevailing time (following all CDC Guidelines) to vote by machine upon the following items.

- 1. To adopt the annual budget of the School District for the fiscal year 2021-2022 and to authorize the requisite portion thereof to be raised by taxation on the taxable property of the District.
- 2. To elect two members of the Board for three-year terms commencing July 1, 2021 and expiring on June 30, 2024. And to elect one member of the Board for a two-year term commencing July 1, 2021 and expiring on June 30, 2023.

NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that at said Annual School District Meeting to be held on Tuesday, May 18, 2021, the following proposition will be submitted. PROPOSITION I

"Shall the proposition set forth in the notice of this meeting authorizing the purchase of five (5) school buses at a maximum estimated cost not to exceed \$520,000 and providing that such sum shall be funded by prior year fund balance, be approved. Section 3. The School District Clerk is hereby authorized to amend the notice of the Annual School District Meeting from time to time, as in his or her discretion, such amendment may be required. Section 4. The resolution shall take effect immediately."

NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that a copy of the statement of the amount of money which will be required to fund the School District's budget for 2021-2022 may be obtained by any residents via the District website at www.schalmont.org beginning Tuesday, April 27, 2021.

NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that petitions nominating candidates for the office of member of the Board of Education shall be filed with the Clerk of said School District at his office in the District Office not later than Monday, April 19, 2021 between the hours of 7:00 AM and 4:00 PM. Each petition shall be directed to the Clerk of the District and shall be signed by at least 25 voters of the District, and must state the name and residence of the candidate.

NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that the applications for absentee ballots will be obtainable by calling the District Clerk at (518) 355-9200 x4002 or by email at jkaras@schalmont.net. Completed applications must be received by the District Clerk at least 7 days before the election if the ballot is to be mailed to the voter, or the day before the election, if the ballot is to be delivered personally to the voter. Absentee ballots must be received by the District Clerk no later than 5:00 PM, prevailing time, on Tuesday, May 18, 2021.
