Capital Project Change Order: Motion made by Mrs. Pasquarella, seconded by Mr. Sheehan, WHEREAS, the Board of Education is to approve change orders related to the capital projects undertaken by the Schalmont Central School District; WHEREAS, the District administration has presented Change Order MA-01 to the contract with Mid-State Industries, Ltd. for the drawdown of the Masonry Work Allowance in the amount of \$5,000 in connection with the Phase 2 Reconstruction at the Jefferson Elementary, MSHS and Bus Repair Garage Project. The change order work is for additional caulking at the gymnasium and the installation of additional weeps at the gymnasium wall. The change order work is due to unforeseen field conditions and is consistent with the scope of work for this Project; and WHEREAS, the work of Change Order MA-01 is to be funded under the specified Masonry Work Allowance and will not increase the Contract Sum or extend the Contract Time. NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education hereby approves Change Order MA-01 and authorizes the District's Superintendent of Schools, or her designee, to execute Change Order MA-01.
