January 30, 2023




### Overview

- Graduates had option of print or online version of survey to fill out.
- District promoted survey through social media and emails.
- 57 graduates responded out of nearly 800 mailed out.




# Which category(s) represents the coursework you took while at Schalmont High School?






When you completed high school, what were your plans after graduation at that time?

- Most graduates responded very positively to question by listing accomplishments and things they were proud of.




Please share some of your challenges since leaving Schalmont High School.

- Social challenges of losing friends after school, work/life balance, "adulthood"




Schalmont prepared me well for the transition after high school.





Schalmont offered electives, extracurriculars, and opportunities that exposed me to career pathways.






Please provide some details as to how you answered the above question.

  - Increased Honors/AP Offerings (7 regarding pathways; 6 about increased rigorous coursework)



Schalmont offered a wide variety of extracurricular clubs, activities, and athletics.






Please provide some details as to how you answered the above question.


Takeaways from comments:

## What skills listed below were you exposed to while you were at Schalmont (please check all that apply)?




What could we have done better to have prepared you for life after Schalmont? Please be as specific and honest as you can!

Takeaways from comments:

- Many graduates mentioned importance of money management and life skills.
- Time management and post-graduate study skills were often listed as important to college success.
- Mental health and wellness support for students was considered critically important.
- Some graduates mentioned importance of ensuring all students had access to opportunities such as clubs or classes.



While at Schalmont, I felt safe (physically and emotionally) when at school.






Please share any information that might help explain your answer to the question above.

- Graduates overwhelmingly said they felt safe at school.
- Many mentioned feeling safe because they had someone to turn to if they needed help.
- Some respondents stressed the importance of emotional support for students, not just physical safety.




There was at least one person I could go to for help while I was at Schalmont.
