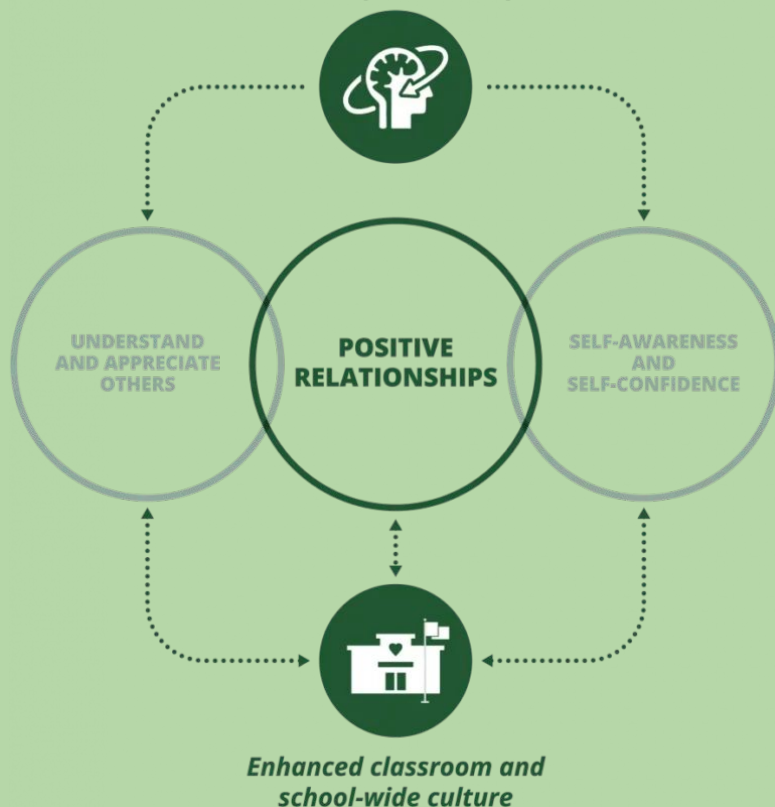

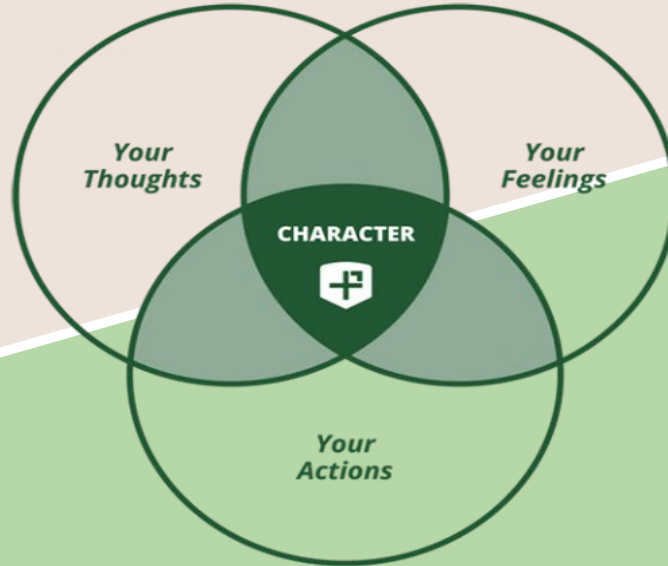

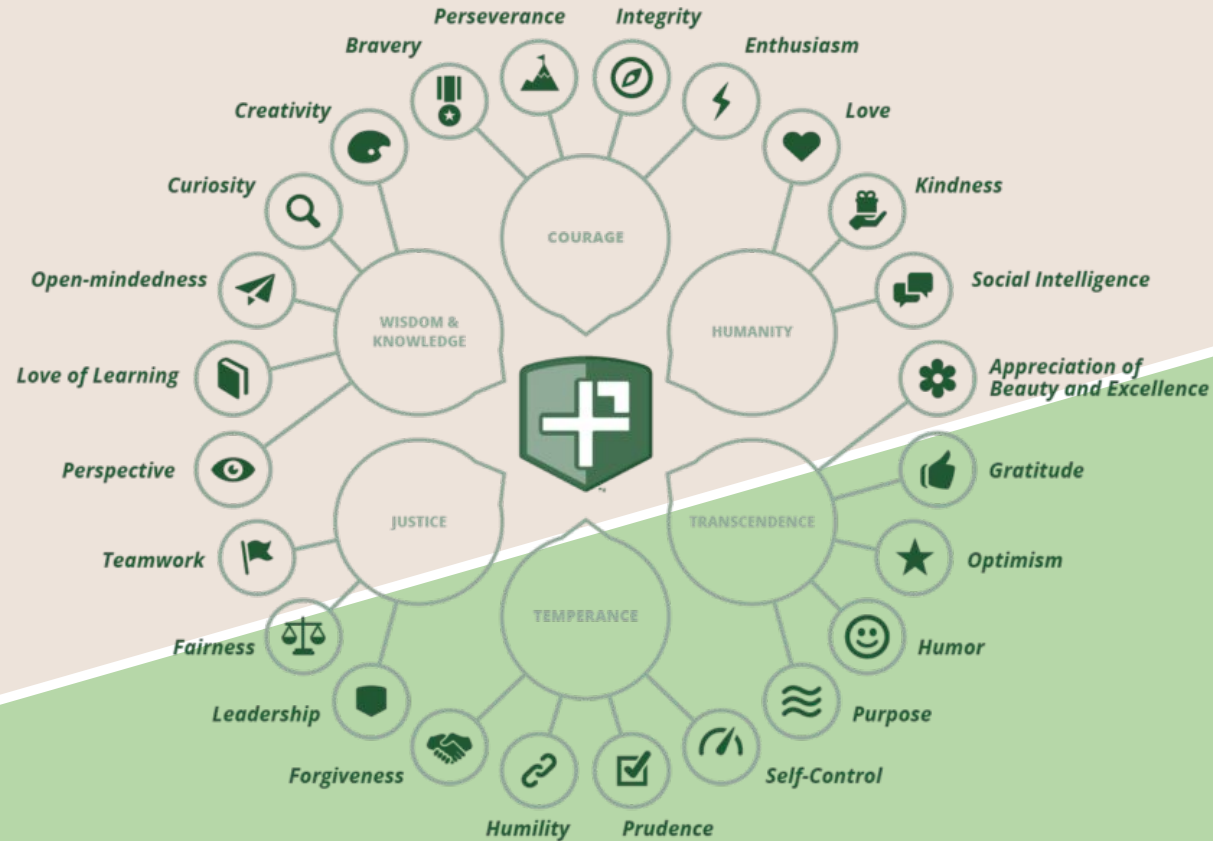

Positive Psychology's 24 Character Strengths



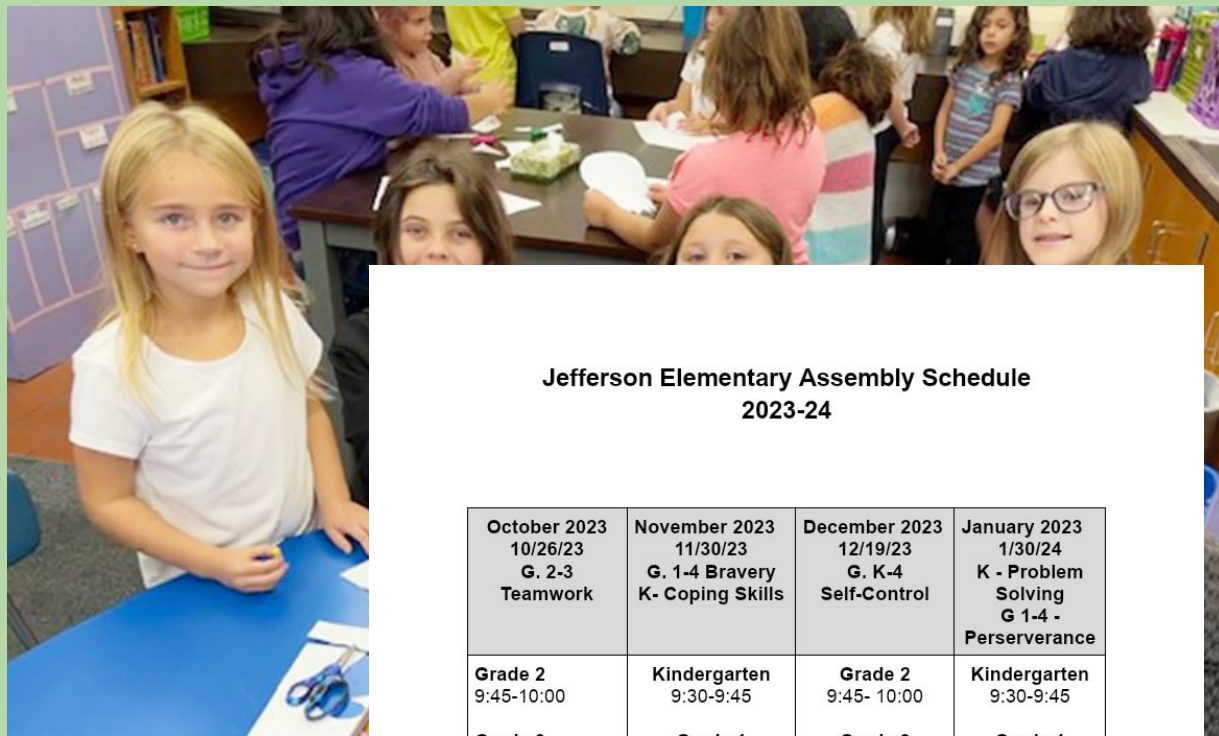
