After more than two years of planning, Schalmont started its Pre-K program this year with three classes at Woestina teaching 54 students. The district hopes to expand Pre-K in the future but is monitoring the new program's cost and community interest to ensure it remains viable for the long-term.

Since reopening in September, our school community certainly has made

sure Woestina feels a part of Schalmont. Almost every week, a group of students, faculty or staff visit to read to Pre-K classes or enjoy activities together.

And our youngest learners are enjoying many school firsts like field trips, picture days, and trunk-or-treat. We can't wait to see what else they learn this year!

Thank you to our families, faculty, staff, and everyone at Dellavale Farm for creating such a memorable very first field trip and experience for our Pre-K students!














What an honor to welcome our community's veterans each year for our Veterans Day Celebration!

And for the first time, our Pre-K families were also able to join the fun as our amazing Jefferson Elementary PTO made sure to include our Woestina families!












Drama Club Performs Romantic Comedy

Senior Families Paint Parking Spots


Amazing creativity and artistry from our Class of 2026 families as they painted their senior parking spots together on a beautiful fall day!
